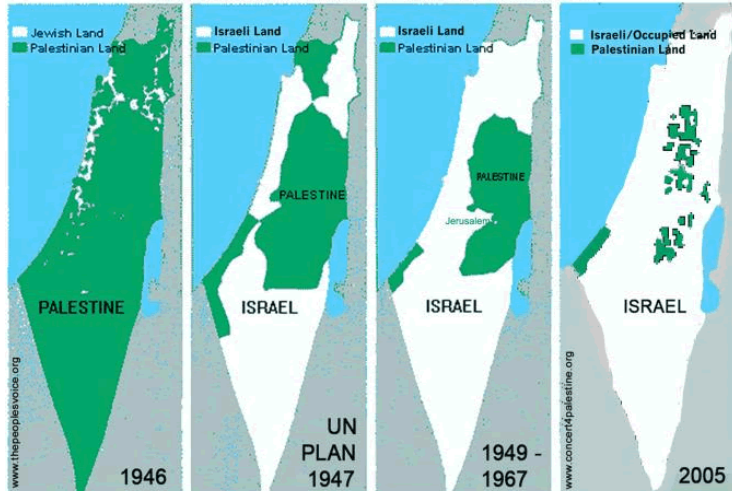
*"I was born and raised in Beit Sahour, the biblical Shepherds' Field just on the outskirts of Bethlehem.*
